## *Center for Specialization of Intelligence Service Personnel (CSISP)*

Center for Specialization of Intelligence Service Personnel (CSISP) is an educational institution of MoD and SAF, within the organizational structure of the Main Section for Support, Military Intelligence Agency (MIA). Its main purpose is to organize and realize the specialization of Course participants for the needs of military diplomacy, intelligence service, reconnaissance units of SAF, as well as foreign armed forces.

CSISP continues its tradition of education from 1955, when the School Security Center was established in Pancevo. The original purpose of the Center was the education and specialization of personnel for the needs of security service, intelligence service and later on, special units. Change of the purpose of the Centre caused a change of its name, so that the School Security Center was firstly renamed into the Intelligence and Security Center and later on, the Security Intelligence School Centre (SISC).

During 2002, SISC was disbanded and two independent centers have been formed: Center for Specialization of Military Security Service Personnel (CSMSSP) and Center for Specialization of Intelligence Service Personnel (CSISP), which continues with the realization of the tasks that in SISC were performed by the Intelligence Department.

**CSISP carries out various types of regular and periodic courses depending on the requirements of those responsible for planning:**

***For the needs of MIA:*** Professional training of candidates for performing duties in Defense Attache Offices, Operational courses for members of MIA, Analytics courses, and other courses in the field of intelligence and operational activities, if needed.

***For the needs of Defence System:*** Preparation of military representatives of the Republic of Serbia to NATO, and in the future, realization of the Intelligence Staff Course for the participation in peacekeeping operations.

***For the needs of the Serbian Armed Forces:*** Reconnaissance courses for officers and NCOs, Climbing and mountain rescue service courses in winter and summer conditions and Skiing course, Nutrition in nature and survival courses and Humint course.

Ministry of Defence and the Serbian Armed Forces have been run. Apart from the fulltime members of CSISP, the lectures are also given by lecturers from MIA, competent persons from MoD and SAF, retired members of MIA, professors from the University of Belgrade and foreign lecturers.

# INTELLIGENCE COURSE

## Teaching content:

- Psychology of Intelligence Activities;

### 3. Extracurricular activities

- Cultural activities - Visits to historical and cultural events and places;

**Language:** Serbian and English

## Enrolment requirements:

Officers who have a degree from military school (Military Academy level) or a relevant university degree qualifying them to perform duties within the intelligence organs, or those whose further career is planned to be continued in intelligence service, can attend the Course.

**Criterion for Course participants:** No prior knowledge required.

**Price:** € 760 - administrative and teaching and training expenses included.

**Pre-course reading:** No requirements.

**Number of courses per year:** 1.

**Number of participants:** 12.

**Duration:** 20 weeks.

**Period:** February - June.

**The course is realized through:** Theoretical and practical contents.

**Requirements for successful completion of the course:** To successfully pass all examinations from the teaching part, and a minimum presence during the course in 80% of all the classes scheduled for the Course.

Upon completion of the Course, participants acquire a certificate proving their competence to work in command's intelligence organs.

## Aim:

To make Course participants competent to independently plan, organize and realize intelligence security, to participate in command activities during decision making process, preparation of documents coming within their competence and coordination of forces in intelligence support of tactical level units battalion-brigade Land Forces.

# RECONNAISSANCE COURSE

## Teaching content:

### 1. General Part:

- Informing;
- Republic of Serbia – geographical position, history and system of government;
- Serbian Armed Forces - organization and tasks.

### 2. Teaching part:

- Professional training includes the following group of subjects:
  - Tactics of special actions;
  - Means and equipment;
  - International humanitarian law.

- Physical education is realized through the Physical Training (PT) subject, which includes teaching contents necessary for maintaining and building mental and physical abilities of Course participants and for making them competent to plan and organize physical training.

### 3. Extracurricular activities:

- Cultural activities - Visits to historical and cultural events and places;
- Sports activities.

**Language:** Serbian and English.

**Enrolment requirements:** Officers and NCOs who currently are performing the duties in reconnaissance units, or whose further career is planned to be continued in reconnaissance units, can attend the Course.

**Criterion for Course participants:** Course participants cannot have any health limitations for the realization of the Course contents with increased physical efforts.

**Price:** € 1.057 - administrative and teaching and training expenses included.

**Pre-course reading:** No requirements.

**Number of courses per year:** 1.

**Number of participants:** 12.

**Duration:** 20 weeks.

**Period:** February - June.

**The course is realized through:** Theoretical and practical contents.

**Requirements for successful completion of the course:** To successfully pass all examinations from the teaching part, and a minimum presence during the course in 80% of all the classes scheduled for the Course.

Upon completion of the Course, participants acquire a certificate of completion of the Reconnaissance Course.

To make Course participants competent to perform individual and collective tasks at the initial commanding duties in reconnaissance units of armed forces, during the performance of specified-purpose tasks in all weather, land and combat conditions.

# OPERATIONAL ANALYTIC COURSE

## Teaching content:

### 1. General Part:

- Informing;
- Republic of Serbia – geographical position, history and system of government;
- Serbian Armed Forces - organization and tasks.

### 2. Teaching part:

- Professional training includes the following group of subjects:
  - Intelligence and Operational Activities;
  - Analytics in Intelligence Activities;
  - Psychology and Communication in Intelligence and Operational Activities;
  - Special means, equipment and weapons.

- Physical education is realized through the Physical Training (PT) subject, which includes teaching contents necessary for maintaining and building mental and physical abilities of Course participants and for making them competent to plan and organize physical training.

### 3. Extracurricular activities:

- Cultural activities - Visits to historical and cultural events and places;
- Sports activities.

**Language:** Serbian and English.

**Enrolment requirements:** Course participants must have a university degree (Military Academy or equivalent faculty), must be familiar with computer skills in Windows environment and with use of basic Microsoft Office Program Packages.

**Criterion for Course participants:** No prior knowledge required.

**Price:** € 1.219 - administrative and teaching and training expenses included.

**Pre-course reading:** No requirements.

**Number of courses per year:** 1.

**Number of participants in the Course:** 8.

**Duration:** 20 weeks.

**Period:** February - June.

**The course is realized through:** Theoretical and practical contents.

**Requirements for successful completion of the Course:** To successfully pass all examinations from the teaching part, and a minimum presence during the course in 80% of all the classes scheduled for the Course.

Upon completion of the Course, participants acquire a certificate of completion of the Operational Analytic Course.

## Aim:

To make Course participants competent to perform duties of operatives (agents) and analysts in the intelligence activities. The Course includes training for: 1) individual and team finding of data sources, planning, organization and realization of recruiting of persons and their intelligence engagement and 2) classification, processing, comparison, evaluation and distribution of data and information.
